

REQUESTS FROM THE FLOOR

- 1) Blaine Ensor approached the Council on his Beautification proposal for the City. After much discussion, a meeting was set for Tuesday, April 26th at 6:00 p.m. at Liberty Theatre
- 2) John Medwedeff addressed the Council on his past due bill for Town Center Park. He requested that the bill be resolved ASAP.
- 3) Rachel Ensor advised the Council of the Historic Preservation & Economic Development presentation at Noon on April 15th
- 4) Mike Ryan stated that he was concerned with the issue on dogs not being allowed to be tethered for more than 10 hours per day. Mr. Ryan suggested that we refocus our concern on more important matters.
- 5) Linda Prescott requested clarification on collection of past due water bills. She inquired as to how far back we can go for collection. Attorney Blake advised that he will research the issue.
- 6) Jed Wallace asked why our ordinances were not being enforced and further stated that Town Center Park was in full ADA compliance.
- 7) Bruce Garibotti declared that there were issues on North 9th Street and the Old Rome. He is concerned about the noise levels, matters of trespassing, public urination, and liquor consumption outside of the Old Rome property.
- 8) Celeste Williams acknowledged that the drinking outside must stop. Ms. Williams is scared that something bad is going to happen. She wants drinking restricted to inside the building only.
- 9) Lisa Dooley was concerned with the parking at the Old Rome. She stated that she was not able to park at her residence and her son was handicap.
- 10) Marilyn Smerken suggested that all issues be reported to the Police Department when the violations occur.
